

Steps to get FCC General Mobile Radio Service (GMRS) License

\$35 • Valid 10 Years • 1 per household

1. Create FCC account: <https://apps2.fcc.gov/fccUserReg/pages/createAccount.htm>
2. Verify account by email (check inbox)
3. Login to FCC account: <https://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsEntry/licManager/login.jsp>
4. Go to CORES (Commission Registration System)
5. Click Register New FRN (FCC Registration Number)
6. Register a CORES FRN as an individual
7. Save/write down the FRN when complete
8. Go to Universal Licensing Manager: <https://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsEntry/licManager/login.jsp>
9. Use FRN as your login, and the password you setup previously
10. Click 'apply for a new license'
11. Choose 'ZA' (the last one) for General Mobile Radio
12. Follow Steps, use all default settings; if you're a convicted felon, you're screwed
13. Log into CORES again
14. Click 'Manage Existing FRNs'
15. Click ULS Pay Fees and follow steps
16. Wait for email approval??

Pretty sure that's it; I checked my account in the ULS and it says submitted but not yet approved. I'm assuming they'll send confirmation when it's done.
